

Letter From FBC Church Member

Bro. Baker,

Just a note to say thank you for putting up www.hacalumni.com. I have been a member of First Baptist Church since 1988, and have put about 20% of my pre-tax income into the church every year since then, plus about \$15,000 towards the building project. I am VERY ANGRY that God's money (and the new auditorium) is now being used by a man who does not believe (and perhaps never believed) that the King James Bible is the inspired, inerrant Word of God.
